

How To Earn Your LCA Therapy Award



The Leonberger Club of America proudly presents the Leonberger Therapy Award. Leonbergers are ideally suited to therapy work with their wonderful temperament, loving attitude and magnificent presence. Therapy work with your Leonberger is a means of volunteering your time to make others a little bit happier. It is a win, win, win effort for the handler, the Leo and the patient. The purpose of the award is to encourage therapy work and to recognize those Leonbergers that have been performing therapy work.

Please read the below listed criteria prior to filling out the Therapy Dog Registration form as listed below.

The LCA will bestow the Leonberger Therapy Award to those Leonbergers who have successfully met the criteria of the award. The recipients of the award will receive a certificate of recognition, a letter of congratulations, a 4-inch patch and 1" pin to be worn on a therapy vest and the right to use the initials LTA (Leonberger Therapy Award) after the Leonbergers name.

Leonberger Club of America criteria to become part of the Therapy Program:

1. Dog needs to be one year of age to enter the program
2. Dog must have earned AKC CGC prior to start of the therapy work.
3. The Therapy Team of dog & handler must be an active member of a recognized national, state or local therapy organization.
4. Owner must be a member in good standing of the Leonberger Club of America.
5. Owner must submit the **Therapy Dog Registration form**.

A Leonberger Therapy Award will be earned by program members following submission of Documented proof of a minimum 50 therapy visits that is signed by the person in charge at the time of the visit.
